On 04-21-2020 at approximately 0111 hours, I responded to 1012 24th St apartment 3, after KARI NASON (V1) called 911 and reported she was choked by her husband and slammed on the ground.

KARI NASON (V1) identified her husband as KRISTIAN NASON (A1) and stated that he was driving away from the residence in his landscaping truck. KRISTIAN NASON (A1) left the residence in his truck before I arrived on scene. Just as I was arriving on scene, other officers reported they were stopping the vehicle that KARI NASON (V1) described at the Samish Way-I5 overpass.

I contacted KARI NASON (V1) inside her apartment and she told me that her and KRISTIAN NASON (A1) got into an argument earlier in the evening regarding marital issues. The argument flared up again just prior to KARI NASON (V1) calling 911. The argument escalated until KRISTIAN NASON (A1) held KARI NASON (V1) by her throat up against a wall in the kitchen. KARI NASON (V1) did not lose consciousness but she experienced pain. KARI NASON (V1) told KRISTIAN NASON (A1) she was going to call 911 and the two began to struggle physically for KARI NASON (V1)'s phone, which was in her pocket. KARI NASON (V1) told me that she also attempted to hold KRISTIAN NASON (A1) at bay by putting her hand on his throat, when he was holding her against the wall. She stated she did this in self defense in response to KRISTIAN NASON (A1) assaulting her.

KARI NASON (V1) walked into the living room from the kitchen. KRISTIAN NASON (A1) followed her and pulled her hair hard enough to cause her to fall down on the ground. A clipboard was flipped over on the floor next to a coffee table in the living room. KARI NASON (V1) said this was knocked over when KRISTIAN NASON (A1) threw her on the ground by her hair.

KARI NASON (V1) had obvious red marks on her throat consistent with her claim that KRISTIAN NASON (A1) held her against the wall by her throat. I photographed her throat and the red marks. There appeared to be broken blood vessels in the skin on her throat as well that were difficult to photograph.

I spoke with officers on scene with KRISTIAN NASON (A1) via cell phone and they advised me that KRISTIAN NASON (A1) initially denied any kind of physical confrontation between them. He later claimed that KARI NASON (V1) pushed him, but he denied assaulting her. Officers out with KRISTIAN NASON (A1) advised that he had a firearm in the truck with him when he was pulled over. He admitted to having the gun in the car. The gun was a Marlin 30-30 caliber lever action rifle.

Bellingham Dispatch later advised that KRISTIAN NASON (A1) was the respondent on a protection order out of Missoula County in Montana: DV-15-1096-DC1. This order explicitly prohibits KRISTIAN NASON (A1) from "Receiving or Possessing a Firearm Under Federal Law (Title 18, U.S.C., Section 922)" Bellingham Dispatch advised that they contacted Missoula County and verified the order was valid and did prohibit KRISTIAN NASON (A1) from possessing a firearm. See follow up reports. Investigator Whipple impounded the firearm for evidence. See Property Tab.

I asked KARI NASON (V1) if she knew about KRISTIAN NASON (A1) possessing a firearm and she told me she did not know he was legally prohibited from owning any firearms, though she knew most of his firearms were impounded by BPD from a prior arrest. She told me she believed KRISTIAN NASON (A1) got this rifle from his step father. See BWC for exact statements. KARI NASON (V1) told me KRISTIAN NASON (A1) had assaulted her in the past and was arrested for it but she did not follow through with pressing charges because she is financially dependent on KRISTIAN

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NASON (A1). KARI NASON (V1) was under the impression that a protection order prohibited KRISTIAN NASON (A1) from contacting her or staying at her residence. KARI NASON (V1) told me that she was willingly having KRISTIAN NASON (A1) stay with her due to the COVID 19 pandemic and her concern for KRISTIAN NASON (A1)'s health due to pre-existing conditions. KARI NASON (V1) believed KRISTIAN NASON (A1) went to his friend's residence in the Edgemoore Neighborhood.

Sgt D Johnson remained on scene with KARI NASON (V1) and read through the Bellingham PD Domestic Violence Lethality LAP form. See DOCS tab.

Due to the above stated facts and circumstances, Probable Cause existed to arrest KRISTIAN NASON (A1) for Assault 4th Degree Dv, Interfering with Reporting Domestic Violence, and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm.

Officer Wagenaar transported KRISTIAN NASON (A1) to Whatcom County Jail. I responded there and filled out a Probable Cause affidavit for the above listed charges. I spoke to KRISTIAN NASON (A1) there briefly. He was argumentative and his speech sounded slurred. His eyes appeared watery and bloodshot and I believed I observed horizontal gaze nystagmus while speaking to him. I was wearing an N95 respirator mask throughout my contact with him so I could not smell anything. Based on my own observations during the booking process, I believed KRISTIAN NASON (A1) was intoxicated based on my training and experience. KRISTIAN NASON (A1) declined to blow into a PBT or take any field sobriety tests.

Officer Longbottom, who was present during the traffic stop with KRISTIAN NASON (A1), responded to the Whatcom County Jail and processed KRISTIAN NASON (A1) for DUI while I completed the Probable Cause affidavit for the other charges related to the initial incident.

Nothing further.

On 04/21/2020 at approximately 0111 hours I responded to physical domestic at 1012 24th Street. Dispatch advised the male involved had left the residence in his truck. As I exited the freeway at I/5 and Samish I observed a truck matching the description given by the female heading eastbound on Samish Way, crossing over I/5. Ofc Lyons and I contacted the driver in the truck who identified himself as KRISTIAN NASON (A1).

When I asked him about the argument involving his wife he stated nothing physical happened. He also stated he had a rifle in the back of his truck. He said he was trying to go to his shop for the night just to put space between them.

Ofc Pena, who had responded to the residence and was out with the female involved, advised there was probable cause for Assault 4 DV. I asked KRISTIAN NASON (A1) to step out of the vehicle. When he stepped out of the vehicle I could smell alcohol on his breath. I removed a utility type knife from his pants pocket during a quick pat down.

KRISTIAN NASON (A1) was eventually taken into custody and placed in handcuffs. I read KRISTIAN NASON (A1) his Miranda Rights and advised him what he was being arrested for.

KRISTIAN NASON (A1) requested a portion of cash he had in his pocket be given to his wife as well as golden retriever dog that was in the back of his truck. His wallet and phone were taken from his truck and brought with him to the jail.

KRISTIAN NASON (A1) gave officers consent to move his truck to the Sehome Haggen parking lot as well as remove his firearm from his truck and impound it at the BPD Station.

I transported KRISTIAN NASON (A1) to the Whatcom County Jail without further incident.

On 04/20/20 at approximately 0111 hours, I was dispatched to a physical domestic at 1012 24th St. While en route, dispatch advised that the RP, KARI NASON (V1), stated that her husband KRISTIAN NASON (A1) slapped and choked her. As officers were arriving on scene, dispatch stated that KRISTIAN NASON (A1) is no longer on scene and left in his Dodge work truck.

Ofc Lyons located KRISTIAN NASON (A1)'s truck in the 300 block of Samish Rd WA/C94792C and conducted a traffic stop.

I arrived on scene at the above address. Ofc Pena was already on scene and advised that he was code 4 with KARI NASON (V1).

I left the residence and arrived moments later in the 300 block of Samish Way to assist with the investigation.

### PERSONAL CONTACT (Observation of the driver)

I contacted KRISTIAN NASON (A1) who was identified by a Washington drivers license. I could smell a strong odor of intoxicants coming from his breath and noticed that KRISTIAN NASON (A1)'s eyes were watery and bloodshot. I observed KRISTIAN NASON (A1) swaying back and forth while he was holding on to the back of his truck tail gate. While speaking with KRISTIAN NASON (A1), his responses appeared to be slurred.

While on scene, I was advised that there was a firearm in the back seat of the truck. While I was speaking with KRISTIAN NASON (A1), Ofc Pena established probable cause for assault 4 (DV). Other officers placed KRISTIAN NASON (A1) in hand cuffs.

### PRE-ARREST SCREENING (Field Sobriety Tests)

Ofc Wagenaar transported KRISTIAN NASON (A1) to the Whatcom County jail to be booked. Ofc Pena arrived shortly later to type PC for the domestic arrest and being unlawfully in possession of a firearm.

Ofc Pena asked if I could respond to the jail to assist further in the DUI investigation.

I arrived at the Whatcom County jail at approximately 0200 hours. I was advised that KRISTIAN NASON (A1) was read his Miranda rights and waived his rights. I asked KRISTIAN NASON (A1) if he had any alcohol tonight. He stated, "no". I advised KRISTIAN NASON (A1) that I could smell alcohol coming from his breath and that I would like to perform a voluntary HGN test on him. KRISTIAN NASON (A1) stated that he refuses to do any tests. I offered KRISTIAN NASON (A1) a chance to blow into a voluntary PBT and he refused.

See scanned documents for the Field Sobriety Tests performance evaluation.

Based on my personal contact with KRISTIAN NASON (A1), the strong odor of intoxicants coming from his breath, his lack of balance while holding onto his

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truck tail gate, and Ofc Lyon's observation of him driving, I placed KRISTIAN NASON (A1) under arrest for DUI.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESS (BAC and Disposition)

While already at the jail, I escorted KRISTIAN NASON (A1) into the BAC room. I completed a mouth check at 0232 hours, nothing found. I read KRISTIAN NASON (A1) his Constitutional Rights from the DUI Arrest Packet, which he stated he understood. KRISTIAN NASON (A1) requested to speak to an attorney. I contacted on call public defended Patrick Lackie at 0234 hours. I exited the BAC room with my body worn camera to allow KRISTIAN NASON (A1) to have privacy with his attorney. I re-entered the room once KRISTIAN NASON (A1) yelled out loud that he was done speaking with his attorney. I completed a second mouth check at 0250 hours. Nothing found. I read KRISTIAN NASON (A1) his IMPLIED CONSENT WARNING for breath and he said that he understood. Due to KRISTIAN NASON (A1) being in handcuffs, I signed cuffed on his signature lines for acknowledgment.

I asked KRISTIAN NASON (A1) if he would submit to a breath test and he stated "No, my attorney told me to refuse."

After the 15 minute observation period had passed, KRISTIAN NASON (A1) verbally stated that he would like to refuse the breath test.

I entered KRISTIAN NASON (A1) as a refusal per his request.

I issued KRISTIAN NASON (A1) citation XZ0376317 for RCW 46.61.502 - DUI . He was given the notice to right of hearing, copy of the citation, and a copy of the breath test document.

Report of Breath was faxed to DOL.

BWC Activated - contact made with victim and with her juvenile son - both were advised of the audio/video recording

On 04/21/20, at about 0111 hours, Bellingham Police were dispatched to a physical domestic dispute at 1012 24th Street. The text of the call indicated that the reporting party's husband had pushed her, choked her, and "slammed" her. The suspect then fled in a work vehicle. I heard over the radio that an officer had located the suspect's vehicle in the area of Sehome Haggen. Two officers were on scene with the suspect's vehicle, but only Officer Pena was at the victim's residence.

I went to 1012 24th Street #3 and joined Officer Pena. Officer Longbottom arrived just after me, and he indicated that he would go to the scene of the stop. I activated my body worn camera. Before entering the apartment, I donned a n95 mask and nitrile-type gloves due to the current Covid-19 pandemic. Officer Pena had already been interviewing the alleged victim, KARI NASON (V1), so I did not hear all of what had been said. Officer Pena also photographed KARI NASON (V1)'s injuries before I arrived. Eventually, Officer Pena went outside to speak with other officers, who were at the scene of the suspect contact, via phone. I obtained KARI NASON (V1)'s name, date of birth, and phone number. When trying to provide me with her phone number, KARI NASON (V1) had some difficulty. She said, "I'm sorry, I'm a little shook up." During this time, KARI NASON (V1) appeared that she was about to cry. KARI NASON (V1) indicated that the police had responded to contact them before, and KARI NASON (V1) believed that there was an order due to him being arrested in March of 2019. KARI NASON (V1) said that she had one child, and KRISTIAN NASON (A1) was not the child's father. The child was 15 years old and was currently in a room in the apartment.

KARI NASON (V1) told Officer Pena and I that she believed that there was a protection order in place between KRISTIAN NASON (A1) and her. She said that she had been letting him stay at the apartment due to his weakened immune system and the current COVID-19 pandemic. She indicated that he had a fifth wheel that he usually lived in. It was my understanding that he was unable to access it at the moment. Officer Pena asked KARI NASON (V1) if KRISTIAN NASON (A1) had any guns with him. She said that his guns were taken away when the previous dv incident occurred. Officer Pena informed her that a rifle had been located in KRISTIAN NASON (A1)'s truck. KARI NASON (V1) then indicated that KRISTIAN NASON (A1) did have the rifle at her apartment. She then looked into her bedroom and said that it was no longer in there. She indicated that she assumed the rifle was his.

Officer Pena asked KARI NASON (V1) if she had any injuries other than on her neck. KARI NASON (V1) said that there might be and said that KRISTIAN NASON (A1) pushed her down to the ground by taking her by her hair and pushing her down to the ground. KARI NASON (V1) then began to cry.

KARI NASON (V1) said that she did not want KRISTIAN NASON (A1) to go to jail, and she said, "He can't keep doing this." I told her that, whatever happened, this was about the choices that he had made, not about the choices that she had made. She talked about his immune system deficiency and said that she had wanted to keep him there to protect him.

Officer Pena returned and advised KARI NASON (V1) that there was no longer a protection order between KARI NASON (V1) and KRISTIAN NASON (A1) but that there was still an order from Missoula, Montana that prohibited him from possessing firearms. Officer Pena asked KARI NASON (V1) if she had pushed KRISTIAN NASON (A1) first,

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because that was what KRISTIAN NASON (A1) was claiming. She said that was not true, and the only time she put hands on him was to push him away when he had his hands around her neck.

While Officer Pena spoke with KARI NASON (V1), I knocked on the son's door. He answered and I asked him if I could speak with him. I then contacted Oscar Larsen inside his room. He told me that he heard a fight between KARI NASON (V1) and KRISTIAN NASON (A1), but he did not see any of it. He described it as sounding violent due to the voices he heard. I asked Oscar if he felt safe there, and he said that he did. Oscar told me that his mother had been drinking some that evening. I told him that she was an adult and was at home, so she was allowed to do that. I asked him if there was anything else I should know, and he told me that he was worried that if KRISTIAN NASON (A1) went to jail then there would be no money for his family and they would lose their housing. I told him that I was sorry that he was having to worry.

After speaking with OSCAR LARSEN (C1), I returned to the living room area. Officer Pena obtained a DVSAS pamphlet and a Domestic Violence Lethality Assessment Screen (LAP) form and asked that I go over those with KARI NASON (V1). I then asked KARI NASON (V1) the Domestic Violence Lethality Assessment Screen (LAP) questions, and she answered in the affirmative to the following questions:

4--Does he/she have a gun or can he/she get one easily?

5--Has he/she tried to choke you?

7--Have you left him/her or separated after living together or being married?

9--Has he/she ever tried to kill himself/herself?

10--Do you have a child that he/she knows is not his/hers?

I spoke with KARI NASON (V1) about DVSAS and told her that I would call and speak with an advocate. She indicated that she would prefer to speak with an advocate later in the day, preferably around 1000 hours. (I later phoned DVSAS from the police station and was put in touch with advocate Marina. I provided her with a summary of what I knew and advised her that KARI NASON (V1) preferred contact around 1000 hours.) I provided KARI NASON (V1) with a DVSAS pamphlet and wrote the case number, Officer Pena's name, my name, and the police department phone number on it.

KARI NASON (V1) was concerned about KRISTIAN NASON (A1) getting his medications due to his weakened immune system. She believed that he likely had them with him in his vehicle, but she checked in her room before I left. She found a plastic sack with various medications belonging to KRISTIAN NASON (A1), and I told her I would take them to the jail for KRISTIAN NASON (A1).

I believed that Officer Pena had asked about any other firearms belonging to KRISTIAN NASON (A1) that were in the apartment. I asked her again, and KARI NASON (V1) indicated that the only other firearm in the apartment was a handgun that belonged to her.

In regard to personal observations, I never made contact with KRISTIAN NASON (A1). For KARI NASON (V1), it appeared to me that she did have redness around her neck/collarbone area. KARI NASON (V1) had difficulty remembering her phone number, but I was uncertain if that was due to the trauma she had experienced, intoxication, or some combination of the two. KARI NASON (V1)'s speech was not slurred and she did not appear to be uncoordinated, so I did not believe that she was obviously intoxicated.

After clearing the residence, I took the medications to the jail. Officer Longbottom was just arriving there to continue his DUI investigation related to this arrest. I provided him the bag of medications to be given to jail staff for KRISTIAN NASON (A1).

These events occurred in the City of Bellingham, Whatcom County, Washington.

On 04/21/2020 at approximately 0155 hours I contacted Officer Pena to determine if assistance was needed with the recovery of a firearm that was associated with this incident.

I responded to 210 36th St. where Officer Longbottom was standing by with the associated 2011 Dodge Ram pickup, WA/C94792C which is registered to KRISTIAN NASON (A1). Officer Longbottom advised me that verbal consent had been given to one of the initial responding Officers, by KRISTIAN NASON (A1) to retrieve the firearm that was in plain view in the backseat of the vehicle.

I recovered a Marlin rifle from the rear seat of the vehicle and cleared it at the scene. Six rounds of "RP 30-30 WIN" headstamped ammunition were removed from the magazine tube. I transported the rifle to the Bellingham Police Department where it was entered, packaged and submitted as evidence. The ammunition was submitted separately.

Bellingham Police Records attempted to run the rifle and was not able to locate a return. I completed the ATF E-trace for the rifle using the following information. The rifle was stamped "The Marlin Firearms Co., North Haven CT USA, Mod 336C, Micro Groove Barrel, Cal. 30/30 WIN" with the serial 91041064. The ATF E-Trace was submitted under T20200147564.

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Follow up generated to document remarks KARI NASON (V1) made during my investigation stating that KRISTIAN NASON (A1) was staying with her since the COVID 19 Pandemic started.

### Narrative:

A1 Nason and the victim, whom he is in a domestic relationship with, got into an argument that escalated until Nason held the victim by the throat with his hand. Nason held her up against a wall and took her phone from her when she threatened to call the police. He then grabbed the victim by her hair and threw her onto the ground. The victim experienced pain as a result of being held by the throat and also when she was pulled to the ground by her hair. The victim had redness on her throat that was consistent with her account, and a clipboard was still on the ground that the victim claimed was knocked onto the floor when she was pulled to the ground by her hair. Nason denied assaulting the victim.

Because there were visible marks on the victim consistent with her account, Probable Cause existed to arrest Nason for Assault 4<sup>th</sup> DV. Nason attempted to prevent the victim from calling 911 by taking her phone when she told him she was going to call 911, therefore, Probable Cause existed for the charge of Interfering with the reporting of Domestic Violence. Nason was pulled over driving away from the scene in a vehicle described by the victim. A loaded 30.30 caliber lever action rifle was in the vehicle with Nason. Missoula County Sheriff's Office Protection Order DV151096DC1 prohibits Nason from possessing any firearms. Bellingham Dispatch contacted Missoula County and confirmed that the order was valid and Nason was prohibited from possessing firearms per the order. Therefore, Probable Cause existed to arrest Nason for unlawful possession of a firearm.




